| 1 | <p>As Jesus entered the streets of Jerusalem they were lined with cloaks and cut branches from trees. "Hosanna to the son of David" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord" When Jesus entered Jerusalem the whole city asked "who is this" the crowds answered "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth in Galilee"</p> | Matthew 21: 8-11 | Any kind of greenery whether cut from a fake plant, a sticker or a picture of a palm branch |
| 2 | <p>Jesus went to pray in the Garden of Gethsemane. He felt unimaginable pain and sorrow. He asked His Father if it were possible for Him not to suffer, but that He would if was God's will. Jesus felt scared like we do but He chose to listen to His Father.</p> | Matthew 26:36-39 | Prayer Hands – I printed the emoji but a sticker or google image would work too |
| 3 | <p>Judas was asked to betray Jesus by the chief priests. Judas asked what they would give him to turn Jesus in. They offered him 30 pieces of silver. Jesus knew of Judas betrayal.</p> | Matthew 26:14-15 | 3 silver coins (3 dimes would equal 30 cents but any silver coins work) |
| 4 | <p>Soldiers placed a crown of thorns on Jesus' head to mock Him for claiming that He is King. They did not believe Him so they inflicted punishment on Him for His "lies." They shouted "hail the King of the Jews"</p> | John 19:2 | I made a crown of thorns with pipe cleaner but you could also use a thorn from a flower |
| 5 | <p>Jesus carried the cross to the place of His crucifixion. Jesus was placed upon the cross.</p> | Matthew 27: 31-32 | Cross sticker, wooden cross, a picture of a cross |
| 6 | <p>Above Jesus' head the soldiers placed a written sign with His charges. It said "THIS IS JESUS, THE KING OF THE JEWS"</p> | Matthew 27:37 | Write "this is Jesus, the King of the Jews" on either a paper or a popsicle stick broken |

| 7 | Once Jesus died, His body was wrapped and placed in a tomb. A stone was rolled over the entrance of the tomb. | Matthew 27:59-60 | Any kind of rock or stone |
| 8 | When Jesus' friends returned to the tomb on the third day since His crucifixion, it was empty. Jesus was alive again! | Matthew 28:5-6 | Leave this egg empty to represent the empty tomb. I read the text separate in order to leave the egg empty. |
